Whereas Walter Boone & Co. agrees with Myatt Mason  
Col. of Southampton County Virginia to advance to  
him from time to time an amount not exceeding  
in all twenty dollars, to enable the said Myatt  
Mason to carry on his farming operations on the lands  
owned by P. & W. Boone & Co. Above therefore in con-  
sideration of the sum advanced and further ad-  
vances agreed to be made from time to time and  
the further consideration of one dollar to the said  
Myatt Mason paid by Walter Boone & Co. the said  
Myatt Mason hereby covenants and agrees that the  
said advances shall constitute a lien upon all  
the crops of every description growing and to be raised  
and grown by the said Myatt Mason upon the  
said lands during the year 1878. The said Myatt  
Mason further agrees to deliver to Walter Boone &  
all Cotton grown on said lands during the year  
1878. To have and to hold for the following pur-  
pose, to wit. If the said Myatt Mason shall  
fail on or before the 1st day of December 1878  
to pay the said debt due the said Walter  
Boone & Co. shall after 15 days notice or  
advertisement at three public places in  
said County. Sell all the property herein con-  
cerned for cash, And out of the proceeds pay  
said debt, interest and costs, and balance  
of such proceeds pay over to the said Myatt  
Mason or his assigns. Given under my
