Whereas Walter Boone Esq. agrees with Nyatt Mason Esq. of Southampton County Virginia to advance to him from time to time an amount not exceeding in all twenty dollars, to enable the said Nyatt Mason to carry on his farming operations on the lands owned by R. J. & W. Neely Esq. Now therefore in consideration of the sum advanced and further advances agreed to be made from time to time and the further consideration of one dollar to the said Nyatt Mason paid by Walter Boone Esq. the said Nyatt Mason hereby covenants and agrees that the said advances shall constitute a lien upon all the crops of every description growing and to be planted and grown by the said Nyatt Mason upon the said lands during the year 1878. The said Nyatt Mason further agrees to deliver to Walter Boone Esq. all Cotton grown on said lands during the year 1878. To have and to hold for the following purposes, to wit: If the said Nyatt Mason shall fail on or before the 1st day of December 1878 to pay the said debt then the said Walter Boone Esq. shall after 15 days notice or advertisement at three Public places in said County sell all the property herein conveyed for Cash, and out of the proceeds pay said debt, interest and costs, and balance of such proceeds pay over to the said Nyatt Mason or his assigns - Given under my hand and seal this 27th day of March 1878.
