1879 and continuing the payments as above
described so long as the said Charles holds
the lots in his possession. The said Drs. P. Leland
further binds himself to give up all claims
to the said lot, as soon as he makes a dif-
ferent payment of the yearly rent as above
described upon a note, written from the said
Charles E. Knight or his representative that such
default has been made.
