between John Pellow Jr & Eva J his wife of the one part  
Lilyay and John C. Davis of the other part witnesseth: that  
John C. Davis in consideration of Four hundred Sixty four &  $\frac{7}{10}$  dollars  
(\$462.70) Dollars paid by said John C. Davis to John  
Pellow Jr. the said John Pellow Jr & Eva J his wife do  
do grant unto the said John C. Davis with general  
warranty a certain piece or Lot of Land Situate  
in the Town of Franklin & bounded as follows:  
beginning at a point on the east side of High  
Street midway between Fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Avenue and  
the intersection of High Street with the boundary  
line of the lands belonging to Mary H. Julian  
& Sarah D. & J. B. & S. B. Pellow thence along  
a straight line parallel with Fourth (4<sup>th</sup>)  
Avenue in an easterly direction fifty five  
(55) feet thence along a straight line  
parallel with the boundary of High Street  
and extending in a northerly direction  
to the boundary line of Mary H. Julian  
& Sarah D. & J. B. & S. B. Pellow about one hun-
