This Deed made this 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1870 between  
 Samuel Kitchen of the one part & B. F. Pickens trustee of  
 the other part, all of Southampton County Va.

Witnesseth that the said Samuel Kitchen do grant unto  
 the said B. F. Pickens a certain tract of land in quantity  
 and warranty containing by estimation Sixty  
 acres more or less and bounded on the north  
 by Round Hill Swamp, on the South by the new  
 Lebanon Road on the East by Peach Orchard  
 Branch; on the west by the lands of George W.  
 Stephenson and the donor interest of Mrs. Caroline  
 Kelle's it being a portion of the lands  
 formerly belong to Mr. W. H. Kelle & Mrs. Gray  
 and purchased by Geo. W. Stephenson. In trust  
 to secure Lettison Davis in the sum of Two Hundred  
 dollars \$200- due by bond bearing even date  
 with this writing and carrying legal interest -

 furniture that I have now in possession and the value  
 of which and is hereby acknowledged and the said  
 Lewis Marks being willing to aid me in providing for  
 my wife and children agree to allow me to keep  
 in possession, the above named property on the  
 following conditions, to-wit: that I am to protect and  
 improve said property for his benefit and pay  
 him annually fifteen Dollars - Rent for the use  
 of said property as long as I am allowed to bid
