

Domini 1879. between Williamson Heale of the first part
of the County of Southampton, Virginia, and Francis &
Brether, (Commission Merchants) of the City of Norfolk of
the other part, witnesses it as follows, to wit: Whereas
the said Heale is at present engaged in the business of
agriculture in said County and the said Francis & Brether
has agreed to furnish to the said Heale during the
present year, goods, groceries, fertilizers and money &
all such articles as may be necessary to enable the
said Heale to carry on his said farm and to cultivate
& raise all such crops as he may undertake to make
during said year, provided all such supplies furnished
and to be furnished by the said Francis & Brether
to the said Heale do not exceed in amount the
sum of five hundred dollars - Now this Agreement
Witnesseth that the said Heale doth hereby grant
and convey unto the said Francis & Brether all such
crops of Corn, Fodder, Cotton, Pea-meats, oats & all
other crops that he may make during the present
year as well as all corn, fodder & other forage, Cotton
seed, hogs, cars, horses, oxen, sheep, together with all
such corn, fodder & other forage including cotton seed
also all the house-hold & kitchen furniture; all the
farming implements including Coats, plows & any
other farming implements now owned by the said
Heale - that is to say all the personal property of
every kind now owned by the said Heale, except
such as may be exempted by the Law, for the pro-
tection of Poor debtors of the State of Virginia. It
being the intention of the said Heale to convey all
of his personal property of every kind, whatever
(except the exemption stated) to the said Francis & Brether
to ~~own~~ - all that the said Heale may now own or
shall or may owe for supplies advanced during the year
