

Domini 1879, between Williamsons & Co. of the first part
 of the County of Southampton, Virginia, and Francis &
 Brother, (Commission Merchants) of the City of Norfolk of
 the other part, witnesses it as follows, to wit: Whereas
 the said & Co. is at present engaged in the business of
 agriculture in said County and the said Francis & Brother
 has agreed to furnish to the said & Co. during the
 present year, goods, groceries, fertilizers and money &
 all such articles as may be necessary to enable the
 said & Co. to carry on his said farm and to cultivate
 & house all such crops as he may undertake to make
 during said year, provided all such supplies furnished
 and to be furnished by the said Francis & Brother
 to the said & Co. do not exceed in amount the
 sum of five hundred dollars - Now this Agreement
 Witnesseth that the said & Co. doth hereby grant
 and convey unto the said Francis & Brother all such
 crops of corn, fodder, cotton, pea-meats, oats & all
 other crops that he may make during the present
 year as well as all corn, fodder & other forage, cotton
 seed, hogs, cows, horses, oxen, sheep, together with all
 such corn, fodder & other forage including cottonseed
 also all the house-hold & kitchen furniture, all the
 farming implements including & etc. plows & any
 other farming implements now owned by the said
 & Co. - that is to say all the personal property of
 every kind now owned by the said & Co. except
 such as may be exempted by the Law, for the pro-
 tection of Poor debtors of the State of Virginia. - He
 being the intention of the said & Co. to convey all
 of his personal property of every kind, whatever
 (except the exemption stated) to the said Francis & Brother
 to ~~store~~ - all that the said & Co. may now owe to
 them or may owe for supplies advanced during the year
