Elliptick and Charlotte P. his wife, for a consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty seven dollars, Do grant with special warranty unto the said Mary Bryan and her heirs and assigns forever the following real estate to wit: a certain tract of land in said County formerly belonging to General A. Lee and Felia his wife and described as follows, containing twenty five and two fifth acres more or less, and bounded as follows, north by the Lands of Wm. Gordon Leeper, East by the Lands of John Whiteley, South by the Lands of Wm. Bryan and west by the Projected Road to J. D. Winborne's mill, and which land is a part only of the tract of Land conveyed to said Wm. E. Elliptick by General A.
