This deed made this 16th day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight between John H. Griffin and Charlie his wife, parties of the first part, and the Beaton Diggs of the second part, one of the parts of Southampton, witnessed: that in consideration of the sum of forty six dollars and twenty five cents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said John H. Griffin and Charlie his wife do grant unto the said Beaton Diggs with several women a certain piece of land containing by actual survey (9 1/4) miles and one quarter less lying in the County of Southampton and bounded with north and east by the lands of Richard S. Brown on the north and west by the lands of said John H. Griffin and Elizabeth Diggs and on the south by the lands of Henry Diggs ~~and~~ and his heirs forever. Witness the following signatures and seals:
