Beaton Esq. of Virginia the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and delivered unto the said W. M. Beaton Esq. One horse Cuck - to have and to hold the same unto the said W. M. Beaton Esq. his heirs, administrators and assigns forever and I warrant and defend the sale of the said horse unto the said W. M. Beaton Esq. from all claims against all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3rd day of February 1879
