 Broadshaw for and in consideration of  
 the premises, doth grant & convey unto the  
 said Trustee the said following property  
 before acceded to with: One Saw mill  
 with all the fixtures & appurtenances of every  
 kind thereto attached; which said Saw mill  
 is now located on the lands of Ellis at New  
 Vaughan in Brunswick County Virginia.  
 A new head of oxen - one carry log cart - two  
 boggy carts - the Saw mill Shetler animal - stable  
 & two plank houses on the said premises hito-  
 rated nearest to the said Saw mill, and  
 the trunk road, with all of the privileges  
 thereto attached, which said trunk road leads  
 from said Saw mill to Courville Detch  
 in Salisbury County. All of which said  
 property is granted & conveyed to the said  
 Trustee to secure the payment of the said  
 twelve bonds of one hundred dollars each.  
 But the said Broadshaw agrees & consents that  
 the said Lewis shall have the use of the said  
 trunk road, if he should so desire in con-  
 junction with the said Broadshaw, for the  
 purpose of hauling out all such cord wood  
 and lumber as he may now have cut  
 may cut up to November the first next  
 and the said Lewis is to have the use of the  
 said oxen, cart & boggy carts up to the said first  
 day of November. And the said Broadshaw  
 further promises and agrees that he will cut  
 all of the cord wood (fire wood) which the  
 said Lewis has purchased of the said Ellis at New  
 Vaughan and pay to the said Lewis twenty  
 cents per cord therefore; that is to say, that the  
 said Broadshaw will cut off all of the said fire  
 wood that is capable of being split, which said  
 cord wood is to be governed by the Rail Road  
 Company & is to be paid for when counted.
