This Deed made this 27th day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy seven between William H. Stephenson and Amanda M. Stephenson his wife of the one part, and E. F. Drewry (trustee) of the other part. Witnesseth, that the said William H. Stephenson and Amanda M. his wife do grant unto the said E. F. Drewry (Trustee) the following property, to wit: one certain tract or parcel of land it being the same on which the said Stephenson now resides, containing three hundred & forty five (345) acres more or less, bounded by the lands of Mrs. W. Stephenson, Estate of Wm. R. Stephenson, Estate of James Valpin, Eli W. Davis & others in trust, to secure the payment of the sum of Two Hundred and Thirty seven Dollars and ninety seven cents, due by Bond to Willie P. Bradshaw of even date with this deed, also a Bond of Two Hundred & Thirty one Dollars and sixteen cents, due W. F. Bradshaw of even date with this deed. This deed releases all former deeds to Willie Bradshaw and also to W. F. Bradshaw, as trustee of E. F. Drewry. In event that default shall be made in the payment of the above mentioned Bonds, then the trustees, or either of them, on being required so to do by Willie Bradshaw and W. F. Bradshaw (or either of them) aforesaid, their successors or assigns, shall sell the property hereby conveyed, and if it is conveyed and agreed between the parties aforesaid, that in case of a sale the same shall be made after first advertising the time, place and terms thereof for twenty days and upon the following terms, to wit: For cash or to so much of the proceeds as may be necessary to defray the expenses of
