said Annie Briggs do grant unto the said A. A. Wil-
liams (Trustee) the following property to wit: all of
her undivided interest in Bennett & Briggs real
estate containing nine hundred acres more or
less bounded by the lands of E. M. Nicholson, Geo. S.
Cohen, Sub of English, J. B. D. Spohart & others.

In Trust, to receive the payments of the sum of
One Hundred & Fifty Dollars (\$150⁰⁰) due Willis
Pradshaw by Bond of this date - In the event
that default shall be made in the payment of
the above mentioned bonds, then the trustee or
either of them on being required so to do by
Willis Pradshaw or his heirs, assigns or
assigns, shall sell the property hereby con-
veyed. And it is covenanted and agreed between
the parties aforesaid, that in case of a sale, the
