 said Richard W. Joyner his heirs and assigns
 that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of
 the above described premises; that they are free
 from all incumbrances, that they have a good
 right to see the same as aforesaid, and that
 they will warrant and defend the same
 to the said Richard W. Joyner, his heirs, and
 assigns, against the lawful claims and dem
