Worrell Trustee of the other part, one of the persons in County of Southampton and State of Virginia and both of Witnessth: that the said party of the first part do grant with general warranty unto the said Benj. E. Worrell Trustee, as appraised the following real Estate to wit: A Tract of Land lying and situated in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing three hundred and thirty three acres more or less, and known as the Waller Place: and formerly belonging to Estate of James T. Pope dec'd. In Trust to repay to J. T. Pope his executors or administrators the payment of the sum of Two hundred dollars, due by bonds as follows One dated Feb. 17<sup>th</sup> 1879 interest from our date, but due Feb. 17<sup>th</sup> 1880 for one hundred dollars, one dated Feb. 17<sup>th</sup> 1879 interest from our date, but due Feb. 17<sup>th</sup> 1881 for one hundred dollars, both of the above named bonds being the balance of the purchase of the said "Waller Place".
