Terminus

This agreement entered into this 14th day of February 1879
between George E. Beaton of the County of Southampton
State of Virginia of the first part, and Jasper Real of
the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that whereas the said Jasper Real is about
to engage in the cultivation of the soil at James
A Johnson's and is desirous to obtain supplies
during the year 1879, from the said George E. Beaton
for the amount of one hundred & fifty dollars
and for taking the aforesaid agreement and for
recording this agreement, and the said George
E. Beaton, having on his part agreed to furnish
said supplies consisting of grain, expenses for
board, &c &c to aid in cultivating said crop
gives the said Jasper Real on his part and in
consideration of the above aforementioned doth hereby
grant a Lien to the said George E. Beaton, on his
entire crops of every description, for the amount
assured to him this year which has been or
was intended to have been expended, and
the said Jasper Real binds himself agreeably
to law to deliver said George E. Beaton through
Cotton, corn, fodder, pens, or other products at
Branchville &c &c by or before the 1st day of December
1879, to satisfy him for the assurance herein mentioned
And in case of default, the said George E. Beaton
is hereby authorized to sell for cash a sufficient
of the crops produced by said Real after giving
ten days notice, to satisfy him for the amount
of assurance herein mentioned, he Real paying
the expenses of sale. This Lien is granted
under an act of the Commonwealth of Virginia
approved April 2nd 1870 entitled an act
to secure the assurance for agricultural pur-
