This agreement made and entered into this
 14th day of Feby: 1879 between J. E. Bailey of the
 first part and W. C. Applewhite of the second
 part, with as follows: that whereas the said
 Applewhite is engaged in the cultivation of
 the soil and is desirous to obtain Supplies
 Fertilizers &c during the year 1879 from the
 said Bailey for the amount of One Hundred
 Dollars. And the said Bailey having agreed
 to furnish the said Supplies, now the said
 Applewhite on his part in consideration
 of the above advances & promises, does here
 by grant unto the said Bailey a Lien on
 all the crops that may be made during
 the year 1879, upon the lands that the said
 Applewhite cultivates for the amount of
 the above advances & the cost of this agree-
 ment. It is furthermore agreed by the parties
 to this agreement that the said crops shall
 be delivered to the said Bailey on or before
 the first day of Dec: 1879, and that no part of
 said crops is to be sold unless it is by and
 through the said Bailey, until this agreement
 is satisfied. Witness our hands this 14th day of
