 and convey unto the said Henry K. White, Vann
 one certain tract of land situated in the County
 of Southampton State of Virginia bounded
 by the lands of H. K. White, C. W. E. Myrick and
 Mary et. White, containing two hundred and
 ten ~~and~~^{and} a half acres to the same more or less
 to him and his heirs forever. In trust however
 to secure the following bond dated and due
 January the twenty eighth, Eighteen hundred and
 seventy nine, for six hundred dollars, with inter-
 est from date to be paid in lawful money
 of the State of Virginia, which debt is due by
 the said William K. Stephenson to the said Henrietta
 Vann. It is stipulated and agreed upon by
 the parties to this deed, that no part of the land
 shall be cut or sold off the land unless the
 sale of such timber is applied to the payment
 of the written named debt or unless such timber
 is used for the improvement of said farm and
 it is further agreed upon by the parties to this deed
 that if the said William K. Stephenson shall fail
 to pay the written named bond and interest the

 say, or expense necessary to execute the provisions
 of this deed, including the said trustee fees for
 court commissions, for all that may be due on
 the said bond principal and interest to the said
 Henrietta Vann or her legal representatives and the
