Broadshaw of Southampton Co., Va. of the second part. Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) the said William H. Broadshaw do grant unto the said David T. Broadshaw with general warranty, all of a certain piece or parcel of land situate in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows on the East by the said David T. Broadshaw on the north by the lands of Jas. McGehee & situate on the west by W. H. Poranch's land known as the Hopewell on the south by Estlin Lewis, containing One Hundred acres (or) more or less.
