This Deed made this 22nd day of July in the
year 1878, between William S. Gosswyn, Commissioner
of the Circuit Court of Southampton County
of the first part and Persons S. Thomas
of the same County of the second part
Witnesseth - That for and in consideration of the decree of the Circuit Court
of Southampton County entered at the
Murray term of said Court in the year
1878, in the Chancery suit of Drury v. Drury
against bothers, and in substance of said
decreed order, the said William S. Gosswyn
Commissioner doth grant, bargain and sell
unto the said Persons S. Thomas of the second
part, the tract of land in said County, lying
on the Three Creeks, containing about acre
more or less, and commonly known as the
Springfield Farm - it being the same tract of
land formerly owned by and the former
residence of Samuel Drury and the same
divided in the will of the said Drury to his son
Joe. C. Drury with the exception of that portion
of said land conveyed by the said Joe. C. Drury
in his life time to Elmer C. Drury and that por-
tion conveyed by the said Joe. C. Drury to John
J. Turner, by deeds recorded in the Clerk's Office
of said County, and that portion of said land
including the mill, commonly known as
Drury's mill, conveyed by the said Joe
C. Drury in his life time to W. S. Gosswyn
and J. J. Edwards commissioners of the Creek
in the same suit above named to William Prince
by deeds recorded in the Clerk's Office of said County
