This Deed made this twenty second day of January Anno Domini 1879, between Samuel B. Pullow Trustee of the first part and Margaret T. Wills wife of John L. Wills, of the other part, all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witnesses as follows: Thomas Wills, John L. Wills and by a certain Deed of Trust dated and admitted to record in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of said County, on the first day of November A.D. 1878, said said Deed and convey with the said Pullow Trustee as aforesaid, certain real and personal estate in the said Deed of Trust described, for the purpose of securing the payment of certain debts in the said Deed of Trust mentioned. And whereas the said Deed has been ordered by some of the creditors to receive, to make sale of the property by the said Deed of Trust conveyed, and after having duly advised the same, upon the said real estate at public auction, on the first day, on the 16th day of this month for cash, and the said Margaret T. Wills became the purchaser for the sum of Eight hundred and five dollars. That is to say, the sum of Eight hundred dollars for the house tract on which the said John L. Wills now resides, and the further sum of five dollars for one of the right, title and interest of every kind of the said J. L. Wills in the estate of his father, James Wills deceased and in the estate of his brother James Wills deceased, making the sum of \$805 dollars, which said sum the said Margaret T. Wills has fully paid to the said Pullow and the receipt of the same is hereby acknowledged.
