 pectancy or vision, in law or equity, which
 the said Louis le Wille may have in the
 estate, real and personal, of his father
 James Wills lately deceased, and in the
 estate real and personal of his brother Thomas
 Wills lately deceased, each of which property
 rights and interest Louis before granted
 and conveyed, to the said Margaret L.
 Wills, are to be held by her as her separate
 property, and may be disposed of by her by
 last will and testament, by Deed of Bar-
 gain and Sale or otherwise, according to
 law prescribing the right of married women
 to control and dispose of their property,
 and especially she may execute a Deed of
 Trust upon the same for the purpose of
 borrowing money.
