named of the other part. Witnesseth that the
said trustee of the first part do hereby grant
and convey unto the said party of the second
part, with general warranty, all that certain
tract or parcel of land which were this day
granted and conveyed by Samuel P. Puelow
trustee to the said Margaret S. Wills, and of
which may be described as follows: To wit; all the
tract or parcel of land wherout the said Lou-
is Wills now resides, which is supposed to con-
tain three hundred and nineteen and a half
