Whereas the said John H. Rollings and Mary
 J. Rollings did by a deed of trust dated July
 21st 1872, and recorded in the Clerk's Office of said
 County of Southampton on the 21st day of July
 1872, grant and convey to the said J. J. Munson
 trustee the tract of land on which the said
 John H. Rollings formerly resided, supposed
 to contain one hundred & forty five and half
 acres, more or less, and bounded by the back
 of J. & Peter Joseph M. Barkow and others to whom
 he owed to E. J. Garrison for the sum of eight
 hundred & forty four dollars and twenty ce-
 nts and whereas the said Mary J. Rollings, ex-
 isting for the late John H. Rollings has since
 the recording of the said Deed of Trust fully
 paid and satisfied all the debts to be secured
 by the said Deed of Trust. Now this Deed wit-
 nesses that for and in consideration of the
 sum of the said E. J. Garrison & John J. Munson
 do hereby remise, release and for ever quit claim
 to the said Mary J. Rollings, administratrix for the
 said John H. Rollings deceased, all claims on
 the said lands herein described and recovery
 and Grant back to the said Mary J. Rollings, ad-
 ministratrix for the said John H. Rollings deceased
 the said land herein described, the sum of all
 the said Deed of Trust had never been executed
 with special warranty notwithstanding
