This deed made this 6th day of Feb. 1879, between Thomas B. Applewhite of one part & J. B. Barham, Trustee of the other part with intent that in consideration of the sum of five dollars, the said Thomas B. Applewhite did hereby grant & convey with general warranty unto the said J. B. Barham, Trustee of the for a certain parcel of land situated in Southampton County, containing 130 acres, be the same more or less, some being same land, conveyed to said Thomas Applewhite by deed of this date from J. B. Barham Trustee Geo. A. Applewhite & Brother M. his wife & Joseph H. Barham reference to which said deed, both general & special is hereby made. In trust to secure the payment of a bond for \$650- on demand & dated 6th day of Feb. 1879, due by said Thomas B. Applewhite to Jos. H. Barham, same being purchase money for said land, and that it be agreed that in the event of a sale of said land by virtue of this deed, it shall be upon such terms as said Barham may desire. After 30 days public notice of time & place and in such town the trustee shall be entitled to five per cent commissions on gross sales.
