 1859, between Martha Weston, James Beale and
 Ebady his wife Frank Weston and Delila his
 wife John Blaythe and Louisa his wife Ebeline
 Weston and Ebady & Weston of the one part and
 Ebwitt Cobb and Martha his wife of the
 other part, witnesseth that in consideration of
 its being the just proportion of lands of
 the Estate of Mr. Weston due going to said
 Martha Cobb as one of his heirs, we the
 said parties first above mentioned do grant
 to the said Ebwitt Cobb and Martha his wife
 all the right title and interest we have
 in a certain tract or parcel of land lying
 in the County of Southampton. Containing
 by survey 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre and bounded as follows:
 beginning at a Sweet grouw corner on Hwy
 4th Westers three staves about East to a Black
 gun corner on Mariah Drakes line, thence
 East along the Lankford branch to a west
 corner on Louisa Cornells line, thence
 South East along said Branch to a poplar
 corner by Ebady & Weston land, thence back
 West to the beginning, and this we grant
