This Deed made the 18th day of February in the year 1879, between Martha Wister, John Blythe and Louisa his wife, James Seale and Emily his wife, Hewitt Cobb and Martha his wife, Adeline Wister and Rhoda A. Wister of the one part and Frank Wister and Selma his wife of the other part, Witnesseth that in consideration of its being the just proposition of the lands of the Estate of William Wister dec'd going to Frank Wister with which he had already received as one of his heirs, we the said parties first above mentioned do grant to the said Frank Wister all the right, title and interest we have in a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton, containing by survey ^{more or less} and bounded as follows:—beginning on west side of the Boggy track on John Blythe's line thence north to the Boggy track to a corner on James Seale and Peter Seale's line, thence west along a line of marked trees to Spring branch, thence along the Spring branch to a corner in front of John Blythe's gate thence East to beginning and thence we grant with special warranty.
