and sixty nine, between Samuel J. Worrell, Wm.
Mary M. Worrell, his wife of the one part, and
Benjamin Piester (Trustee) of the other part, Wt.

Whereas, it is the said Samuel J. Worrell and
Mary M. his wife doth convey unto the said
Benjamin Piester (Trustee) the following pro-
perty to wit; all of that piece or parcel of land
described to the said Samuel J. Worrell by

Fannie Stephenson, R. M. Stephenson and Elizabeth
L. his wife, containing one hundred and fifty
acres, more or less, and bounded as follows
on the north by lightwood swamp, on the south
by the road leading from Smithfield Church-
town, on the east by the lands of Lewis
Stephenson, on the west by the road leading
from Jerseytown to Smithfield. In such to
secure the payment of the sum of Four Thousand
Dollars (\$4000⁰⁰) due by four different Bonds
