This Agreement entered into this the 20th day
of February 1879 between W. M. Peaton and Wal-
ter Boone, Merchants and partners trading un-
der the firm or name of W. M. Peaton & Co. of one
part, and J. H. Holland and E. P. Holland of the
other part. Witnesseth: That whereas the saids
J. H. Holland and E. P. Holland are about to engage
in the cultivation of the soil, and are desirous
to obtain during the year 1879 advances in sup-
plies from the said W. M. Peaton and Co. to the
amount of One Hundred Dollars, beyond which
limit the said J. H. Holland and E. P. Holland
shall not go; and the said W. M. Peaton & Co.
having agreed on their part to furnish the said
advances, now the said J. H. Holland and E. P.
Holland on their part, in consideration of
the above premises do hereby grant a lien to
the said W. M. Peaton & Co. for the crops which
may be made during the year 1879 upon the
lands in the cultivation of which the above
amount of advances has been or was intended
to have been expended. This lien is granted un-
der an act of the General Assembly of Virginia
approved April 2nd 1873, entitled "An Act to
secure Advances for Agricultural Purposes".
