This Deed made this third day of March in the
Year 1879, between John Blythe and Louisa Blythe
his wife, of the County of Southampton in the
State of Virginia of the one part, and J J Kind-
red of the County of Southampton and State
of Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth, That the
said John Blythe and Louisa Blythe his wife, do
grant with general warrants unto the said J J.
Kindred the following property, to wit:
All of that tract of land situate, lying and
being in the County of Southampton in the State
of Virginia and bounded and described as
follows; It being the farm on which the said Blythe
now lives and bounded on the north by the lands
of Frank Weller, on the south by the lands of Robert
Blythe on the west by the lands of Martha Weller
and on the east by the lands of William Rose
and said to contain fifty two acres more or less
together with all and singular the improvements and
appurtenances belonging to the same, in trust to occur
to W H Jenkins & Co. of the County of Southampton in
the State of Virginia, the payment of the sum of
a note made by the said John Blythe dated the
3rd day of March 1879 and payable to the said W H.
Jenkins & Co. January 1st 1880 being for the sum
of One hundred & twenty five Dollars, and it is
