This deed made this 17th day of March 1899, between
J. W. Urquhart, Trustee party of the first part, et. O. Red-
ley party of the second part & Wm. M. Beaton party of
the third part. Whereas by a deed dated the 1st day
of January 1876 & of record in the Clerk's Office of the
County Court of Southampton County, the said et.
J. Ridley & M. O. Ridley his wife in order to secure
the said Wm. M. Beaton the payment of two bonds
the first for the sum of \$1620⁰⁰ bearing date the 1st
day of January 1876 & payable ^{one} term of years, after
the second for the sum of \$1750⁰⁰ bearing date the 1st day of January 1876 & payable ^{one} term of years, after
the date of both executed by the said et. O. Ridley
& payable to the said Wm. M. Beaton, did convey
in trust to the said J. W. Urquhart certain property
& described in said deed as follows; that is to
say, a certain tract or parcel of land known as
Boykins Farm, partly in Virginia & partly in North
Carolina, containing 1450 acres more or less & bounded
as follows; beginning at Boykins Bridge over the
Meherrin River, bounded west by the County Road
which leads from said Bridge to Boykins Shop
on the north by the branch called the Gun Branch
which constitutes the line between said land now
sold & the Estate of Henry Kinross deceased, on the
East by the lands of the Estate of Josiah Worrell dec^d
& of Henry Cooke dec^d & on the South by the Meherrin
River & is the same land this day conveyed by Wm. M.
Beaton wife to et. O. Ridley together with all & singular
the appurtenances belonging to said lands & whereas
the two said bonds have been fully paid & the said et.
O. Ridley binds the said property to be released to him
now therefore this said witness, that said et. O. W.
Urquhart Trustee as aforesaid in consideration
of the premises & by & with the consent of the said
Wm. M. Beaton testified to by his becoming a party
to this deed & signing & sealing the same, doth grant
