He further agrees to send Cotton to pay the rent to any Commission House they desire & further agrees to send Cotton to any Commission House they desire to pay for any & all supplies they may advance to him & this shall constitute a lien on all his crops until they are paid & I do hereby waive the benefit of my homestead exemption as to this contract.
