Butler all their entire interest in a certain tract of land lying in Southampton County containing seventy five acres more or less and bounded by the lands of G. D. Butler Albert Bryant and others in trust to secure a debt due G. D. Butler for the sum of two hundred and ninety one dollars and 25 cts to be paid in five yearly instalments, notes bearing date with these presents and payable as follows, to wit: One note for sixty four dollars and 40 cents payable the first day of Dec. 1879, one note for sixty five dollars and twenty cents payable the first day of Dec. 1880, one note for sixty one dollar and 25 cents due the first day of Dec. 1881, one note for fifty seven dollars and 25 cents due the first day of Dec. 1882, and one other note due Dec. first 1883 for forty three dollars and 25 cents. Given under our hands and seals the day above written.
