Witnesseth: That whereas the said Chas. D. Delt is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain during the year 1879, advances in money or supplies from the said James M. Corbitt to the amount of One hundred and fifty dollars beyond which limit the said Chas. D. Delt shall not go; and the said James M. Corbitt having agreed on his part, to furnish the said advances, now the said Chas. D. Delt on his part in consideration of the above promises, does hereby grant a lien to the said James M. Corbitt, on the crops which may be made during the year 1879, upon the land in the cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been expended. This lien is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2nd 1873, entitled "An Act to Secure Advances for Agricultural Purposes."
