This Agreement entered into this 20th day of February 1879, between James M. Corbitt merchant, trading under the firm name of James M. Corbitt of the one part, and George Artie "C. C." of the other part Witness that whereas the said George Artie is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain during the year 1879, advances in money or supplies from the said James M. Corbitt, to the amount of Two hundred dollars, beyond which limit the said George Artie shall not go; and the said James M. Corbitt having agreed on his part to furnish the said advances, now the said George Artie on his part, in consideration of the above premises, does hereby grant a lien to the said James M. Corbitt on the crops which may be raised during the year 1879, upon the land in the cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been expended.
