property hereby conveyed. And it is covenanted
and agreed between the parties aforesaid
that in case of a sale, the same shall be made
after first advertising the time place and
terms thereof for twenty days and upon the
following terms, to wit: for cash as to so much
of the proceeds as may be necessary to defray
the expenses of executing this trust, the fees for
drawing and recording this deed, if then
unpaid and to discharge the amount of money
then payable upon the said Board, and if there
be any residue of said purchase money, the
same shall be made payable at such time and
manner in such manner as the said George W.
Brown his executors, administrators or assigns
shall prescribe and direct, or in case of
failure to give such direction, at such time
