Broadshaw of So:auption Co. 4<sup>th</sup> of the first part and Joel S. Broadshaw of So:auption Co. 7<sup>th</sup> of the second part: With intent that in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and twenty five (\$325<sup>00</sup>) Dollars, the said David L. Broadshaw and Amy J. Broadshaw do grant unto the said Joel S. Broadshaw with General Warranty, all of a certain piece or parcel of land situate in the County of So:auption on Black Creek road and bounded as herein described; commencing at Pine on ditch on road, thence S. West along ditch and David Broadshaw's line, thence along ditch S. Westly and thence S. West to opposite Maple P. O., thence S. W. along chopped line to Pine Cor. on W. H. Broadshaw's line, thence S. Westly along chopped line to S. Pine Cor. on James Hedgepeth's line, thence S. Eastly along ditch said Hedgepeth's line to Pine Cor. thence S. along ditch to County road of Small Beck Gunn-Rafords, thence along said road to opposite Pine at Commencement, containing One hundred (100) Acres more or less.
