This Deed made the 18th day of February in the year 1879, between Martha Mester James Beale and Emaline his wife Hewitt Cobb, and Martha his wife Frank Wester and Delila his wife, John Beatty and Louisa his wife and Phoebe Wester of the one part, and Abeline Wester of the other part Witnesseth, that in consideration of the being the just proportion of the lands of the Estate of William Mester dec'd going to said Abeline Mester as one of his heirs, we the said parties first above mentioned do grant to the said Abeline Mester all the right, title and interest we have in a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton, containing by survey 40⁷⁵/₁₀₀ acres and bounded as follows:—beginning at a corner on James Beale's line thence East to a Red oak stump corner on Marsh Danks and Rhody & Wester's line thence South East to a pine corner on Phoebe & Wester and Patey Joyner's lines thence South west along a line of marked trees to a corner on James Beale's line thence north West to the beginning, and this we grant with special warranty
