

This Deed made the 18th day of February in the
 year 1879 between Martha Wester et al v. Cobb, our
 Martha his wife, Frank Wester and Delila his
 wife John Blythe and Sonisa his wife, Adelicia Wester
 and Henry A. Wester of the one part and James
 Beale and Emilie his wife of the other part
 witnesseth that in consideration of its being
 the just proportion of the lands of William
 Wester dec^d going to Said Emilie Beale
 as one of the heirs, we the said parties first
 above mentioned do grant to the said James
 Beale and Emilie his wife all of the right
 title and interest we have in a certain
 tract or parcel of land lying in the County of
 Southampton containing by survey $100\frac{95}{100}$ acres and
 bounded as follows:— Beginning at a Red oak
 corner of John Blythe and Pately Jaynes then
 west up the Boggy track to a pine corner between
 Peter Scott and Frank Wester, thence East to
 a corner on Adelicia Wester's line thence and
 east to a corner on Adelicia Wester's line
 thence west to a Red oak at the beginning
 and thus we grant with special warranty
