 this agreement made this 5<sup>th</sup> day of March  
 1879, between the said Richard H. Jones of one

 & Brooks of the other part Witnesseth, that  
 in consideration of the above premises  
 the said Jones does hereby give & grant  
 unto the said Niemeyer Eberdige & Brooks  
 a lien on all the crops he may make  
 during the year 1879, to secure the advances
