Darden another crop of cotton, peanuts & corn or enough to pay above amount which crops are to be made this year on the land of E. B. Ridley, and I hereby waive the benefit of the Homestead exemption as to the debt or contract for the amount advanced to him this year which has been or was intended to have been expended, and the said Cowling binds himself agreeable to law to deliver his Crops above mentioned to Jas. J. Darden at Chewson's Dock T^a by or before the 1st day of December 1879. This deed is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd 1873 entitled an Act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes.
