Whereas W.B. Lamb is indebted to P. S. Pope  
and desires to pay him, now this paper witnesseth  
as follows. That I hereby sell unto the said Pope  
the following personal property Estate to wit, five  
Cows and their increase one cow and two  
cows and their increase, One Cow-mill, one  
Cort and two pair wheels, One beggry and han-  
moss. Cider mill and Presses. Twenty five Cider  
Cask, Still and fixtures. Four beds and Steads  
all of my farming implements, all of my inter-  
Household and Kitchen furniture, but the  
said Pope agrees that I may retain possession of  
some for one year from this date and if I pay  
said Pope what I owe him that I may have  
the said articles as my own, and whereas the  
said Lamb is desirous of obtaining resources in  
money or supplies during the year 1879, to enable  
him to carry on his farming operations and whereas  
the said Robt. S. Pope has agreed to furnish  
the same to an account not exceeding two hun-  
dred and fifty dollars, now this paper further  
witnesseth that in consideration of the above the  
said Lamb hereby gives and grants unto the said  
Pope a lien upon all the crops of every kind.
