That I hereby sell unto the said Pope the following personal property Estate to wit: five Cows and their increase one cow or ox, two sows and their increase, One Barrel, One or, One Cart and two pair wheels, One Henny and her nest, Cider mill and Press, Twenty five Cider Cask, Still and fixtures, Four beds and stands all of my farming implements, all of my interior Household and Kitchen furniture, but the said Pope agrees that I may retain possession of same for one year from this date and if I pay said Pope what I owe him that I may have the said articles as my own, and whereas the said Saub is desirous of obtaining advances in money or supplies during the year 1879, to enable him to carry on his farming operations and whereas the said Robt. S. Pope has agreed to furnish the same to an amount not exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars, now this paper further witnesseth that in consideration of the above the said Saub hereby gives and grants unto the said Pope a lien upon all the crops of every kind,
