that the said Orris Moore doth convey to
the said Oswin White all his right title and
interest in one tract of land containing by
estimation ninety three acres more or less
on which the said Orris Moore now resides
and bounded by the lands of E. J. Story, Elizabeth
McClenny and others; in trust to secure the
payment of one bond due Zachary Doyle
for the sum of One hundred and eighty five
dollars and bearing date the 26th day of
April 1876. If the said Orris Moore should
fail to pay the said bond with eight per cent
interest or any part thereof when demanded
by said Doyle or his legal representative, the
