Parker doth bargain, sell, grant and convey with general warranty unto the said Romine E. Sebrice, her heirs and assigns a certain lot or parcel of land with all the buildings or appurtenances thereto attached or belonging (save a smoke house used at present by said Frederick J. Parker) situated in Jerusalem W^a beginning on main Street at the Corner of the lot upon which Dr. E. B.
