This Agreement entered into this the 18th day of
March 1879, between W.M. Beaton and Walter Boone,
merchants and partners trading under the firm name of
W.M. Beaton & Co. of one part and Harrison Chambless
of the other part. Witnesseth: That whereas the said
Harrison Chambless is about to engage in the cul-
tivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain during
the year 1879 advances in money or supplies from the
said W.M. Beaton & Co. to the amount of two Hun-
dred Dollars beyond which limit the said
Harrison Chambless shall not go; and the said
W.M. Beaton & Co. having agreed, by their part
to furnish the said advances now the said
Harrison Chambless on his part in consider-
ation of the above premises does hereby grant
a lien to the said W.M. Beaton & Co. on the crops
which may be raised during the year 1879 upon
the land in the cultivation of which the above
amount of advances has been or was intended
to have been expended. This lien is granted under
an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia
approved April 2nd 1873 entitled "an Act to Secure
Advances for Agricultural Purposes".
