Andrews having agreed, on his part, to furnish the said advances, now the said Edw. Worrell on his part, in consideration of the above premises, does hereby grant a lien to the said R. P. Andrews on his crops which may be made during the year 1879, upon the land in Cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been expended. This lien is granted under and Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2nd 1873, entitled "An Act to secure Advances for Agricultural Purposes" Witness the following Signatures and Seals
