H. Dutcher and Nancy H. his wife of the County of Southampton  
Bogart Franklin State of Virginia of the first part and John H. Bogart  
of the County and State aforesaid of the second  
part witnesseth, that the said parties of the first  
part, for and in consideration of the sum of four  
hundred and twenty five dollars to them in hand  
paid by the said John H. Bogart, the receipt of which  
is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained, sold and conveyed  
and by these presents doth bargain, sell and convey  
unto the said John H. Bogart, his heirs and assigns, a lot  
of land in the Town of Franklin, Southampton C.  
containing one clay street, located as follows: beginning at a  
point on the west side of Clay Street 656 ft. 8 in S  
 $59\frac{1}{2}$ ° east from the junction of the west  
side of Clay Street with Corporation limits at
