having obtained by loan of the sum of One thousand  
and ten in the sum of twelve hundred & fifty dollars  
(\$1250) & have executed his note for same bearing  
the date with this deed payable nine months  
after date with interest from date & have waived  
the Homestead in the payment of same, now  
the said W. B. Westbrook being anxious  
to secure the payment of said note with its  
accrued interest will & truly to be made, have  
this day granted bargained & sold, & by these  
presente doth grant sell & convey unto the  
said Joseph B. Prince in Trust for the pay-  
ment of the above mentioned note, The following  
property herein after named To wit: a certain  
tract or parcel of land known as the Thos<sup>2</sup>  
H. Westbrook farm lying & being in the County  
of Southampton State of Virginia, containing  
460 four hundred sixty one acres, be it  
more or less, lying on the north side of Blow's
