This agreement made and entered into this 22nd day of March 1879 between Ben Evans of the first part and Matthew Evans of the second part witnesseth as follows that whereas the said Matthew Evans engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies Fertilizers¹⁵ during the year 1879 from the said Ben Evans for the amount of Two hundred Dollars. And the said Ben Evans having agreed to furnish the said supplies now the said Matthew Evans on his part and in consideration of the above advances and promises does hereby grant unto the said Ben Evans a lien on all the crops that may be made during the year 1879 upon the lands that the said Matthew Evans cultivates for the amount of the above advanced cost of this agreement. It is furthermore agreed by the parties to this agreement that the said crops shall be delivered to the said Ben Evans on or before the first day of Dec 1879 and that no part of said crops shall be sold until it is by and through the said Ben Evans until this agreement is satisfied Witness our hands this 22nd day of March 1879.

This Deed made this 23rd day of March 1879 between Joseph W. Cland of one part and Joseph B. Prince of second part witnesseth: that in Consideration of Two hundred & fifty six ²⁵/₁₀₀ dollars receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Cland does hereby grant & convey with general warranty to said J. B. Prince and his heirs forever the following parcel of land to wit: a certain piece of land lying in Southampton County containing by actual survey 102 1/4 acres and bounded by the lands of J. C. Prince, Joseph W. Cland & the Newton Place - for a more particular description of which, reference is made to a plat hereto annexed as a part of this deed. The said land is composed of land sold said Cland by W. A. Jones, and the land bought by W. A. Jones of G. J. Jones along with the will annexed of Joel McGinnis by deed recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton during the year 1844 - witness
